If you have not yet had a chance to look at the newly upgraded Kindergarten, First Grade and Second Grade classrooms, we encourage you to stop in and check them out. Over the summer we were able to work on these three classrooms, bringing our total up to four classrooms all together. This work is due to the generosity of Cathedral School alumni. In addition, because the classrooms included energy efficient LED lighting, we were able to apply for over \$1,500 in rebates from Focus on Energy. This money will go into the fund for future classroom upgrades.
