Brandon had been battling cancer for over ten years and the previous month his doctors had given up on his chances for survival. He died the following spring.

The next Christmas Season his mother once again saw Angels on display and decided to add to the one Brandon had picked out. Thus started the **Brandon Christopher Collection**. Each year more and more Angels were collected from craft fairs, boutiques, garage sales, and Christmas displays until twenty five years later a total of **845 Angels** were united!

Today, due to an impending sale of the family home and retirement, Brandon's mom has decided everything must go including her beloved Angels. She has most generously decided to donate the entire collection to Cathedral School to be used as a fundraiser for the School's Angel Fund, money set aside to assist students or their families in time of financial need.
